Show order: Showmanship, Market, Dairy Goats, Meat Goats, Fun Classes

Rules and Regulations

1. 4-H and FFA members must show an animal in the showmanship competition provided it has been carried as a project and is owned by the exhibitor.
2. Substitute Showman are not eligible for Showmanship Awards.
3. Refer to Dept 10 General 4-H and FFA member rules and regulations.
4. All 4-H/FFA entries must be submitted to EACH Open Barn Chairperson, postmarked/due on or before July 22, 2025.
5. Please use Fair Entry to enter your classes for Dept 10.
6. Refer to General, Health and Code of Conduct rules.
7. No exhibitor may enter more than two market animals.
8. There will be NO on the spot show changes.
9. 4-H and FFA members may have assistance showing additional animals only if they are already in the ring and have two or more animals entered in a class.
10. Exhibitors must provide own feed, bedding, buckets, hoses, hay feeder and general supplies.
11. No exhibitor may have more than 3 entries in each class. No exhibitor may have more than 2 entries per class in the market class. Only one entry in group classes and best doe bred by exhibitor. Exhibitors are limited to ten (10) animals each.
12. If animals are not registered, they must have a scrapie tag.
13. Drugs administered to livestock prior to or during the fair for the purpose of controlling disposition or showmanship performance is prohibited.
14. Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Chairman, to accept the stall assigned without controversy, to keep animals in an attractive appearance, and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may serve to increase the educational value of the show. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will result in dismissal.
15. All animals entered in the competition must be on the grounds no later than 3:00 p.m. on Monday, August 4, 2025. All animals shall remain on the premises until 8:00 p.m. Saturday, August 9, 2025, unless released by the Chairman. Request for early release of animals shall be submitted to the Chairman in writing along with entry form.
16. ALL GOATS, INCLUDING WETHERS, MUST BEAR AN OFFICIAL W.S.D.A./A.P.H.I.S. EARTAG TO BE EXHIBITED AT THE SHOW. THE ONLY EXCEPTIONS ARE THOSE GOATS THAT HAVE A REGISTRATION TATTOO AND HAVE BEEN CODED WITH A PREMISE I.D. NUMBER.
17. No bucks allowed. Disbudding of all animals is encouraged.
18. All goat exhibitors (or a representative) are expected to help clean up the barn and take down the pens. Clean up will be Sunday, August 10, 2025 at 7:00 a.m. If you have a conflict and are not able to help clean up, contact the barn chairperson prior to the start of the fair.
19. All junior exhibitors will compete in showmanship or forfeit their premiums.
20. Homebred Class must consist of 1 market animal chosen prior to the start of the show. This cannot be a purchased Market project. Exhibitors must own the dam prior to breeding.
21. Members must have documentation showing ownership of dam with proof of either service memo or ownership of sire.
22. For Just for Fun Classes, exhibitor show only 1 animal.
