## Rules and Regulations

1. Eligibility: Class is open to any 4-H or FFA member currently carrying a poultry project. The exhibit must be raised by the exhibitor and be related to his or her current project.
2. 4-H members must be enrolled in the 4-H poultry project by program enrollment deadlines (see page 26) All birds must be enrolled by June 1, 2026. 4-H project and record books must be up-to-date and must be judged at 4-H Round-Up on Saturday, August 9rd, 2026.
3. This Exhibition LIMITED to Pennsylvania flocks only and preference given to Tioga County Exhibitors.
4. No entry fee will be charged for 4-H/FFA classes (Dept. 10).
5. All 4-H/FFA poultry exhibitors must have a current "Quality Assurance Certificate".
6. 4-H/FFA members may show two birds per individual class. Youth may show any of the following combinations in the market poultry classes: two pens of chickens, one pen of chickens and one turkey, or one of either species. No youth will have more than two poultry items in the livestock sale.
7. Broiler meat birds will be weighed and must be between 5 and 10 pounds. Turkeys must weigh between 20 and 50 pounds.
8. Meat Birds MUST be obtained from the Tioga County Fair Poultry Department.. Information will be available about the purchase of birds in February & March. Birds may not be obtained from outside sources. Please contact the Tioga County Fair Poultry Department Chairperson with any questions.
9. 4-H & FFA exhibitors must be the sole owner and raiser of the turkey and or broilers. Youth of the same family may raise birds together, but it is expected that each youth takes equal care of the birds and are caring for the birds daily.
10. All birds entered in the Meat Pen class will be processed after the show and sold at the Junior Livestock Sale. All meat birds are terminal projects.
11. Meat birds do not have to be sold to compete as market animals, unless they are Grand or Reserve Champion.
12. 4-H or FFA members must be present and have charge of their birds at the time of judging and sale.
13. Refer to the Open Poultry Department 8 for rules, regulations, and class lists for breeding birds.
14. The production breeds class is for hybrid or crossbred chickens that are used for egg laying purposes but may not fit in another breed standard.
15. To arrange testing and banding for your birds, contact the poultry chairperson. Testing must be completed within 14 days of the show. There are several local testers that may be available to test birds.
